

CONFORTECK™ LITHIUM WITH TWO OUTPUTS INTEGRATED CONTROLLER



INSTRUCTIONS AND SECURITY RULES

Please read this document entirely including directives and security warnings BEFORE using or recharging this product. Li-ion batteries are volatile. Failure to read and follow the instructions below may result in fire, personal injury and damage to property if charged or used improperly.

Recharge: Use specific charger only (Li-ion). Do not plug the battery to any other power source or cigarette lighter ("in car" jack). Follow directives and warnings for your security.

- Battery must be charged before first use. Battery may become a little warm and charger a little hot during charging procedures; this, however, poses no danger.
- The charging time may vary depending on the surrounding temperature.

(About 5 to 6 hours.)

- Plug the charger to a 115-Vac power outlet. The charger's LED will be green.
- Insert the charger's DC plug into one of the outputs of the battery. The LED of the charger and the LED of the battery will become red.
- When LED of the battery become green, the battery is recharged but the charger will continue charging cycle for some time (maybe one hour). The LED of the charger will start flashing from red to green and this will intensify until the LED is solid green.
- The charging cycle is now complete.
- At the end of the charging process, unplug the charger from the battery and from the AC outlet.

Danger: The temperature range over which the battery can be charged is 5°C to 35°C. Charging the battery at temperatures outside of this range may cause the battery to become hot or to break, even explode. Charging the battery outside of this temperature range may also harm the performance of the battery or reduce the battery's life expectancy. Never recharge a battery that is frozen or hot. Let the battery reach recommended temperature before recharge. Cease charging cycle if the battery is not completely recharged after 8 hours or if the battery become abnormally hot.

Use/Discharge: Use only with compatible ConforTeck™ equipment for a total draw of 3 amp maximum (36 Watts).

Without equipment: Press and hold button to indicate remaining capacity

- Red: 90% to 100%, battery is full
- Orange: 30% to 90%, mid-level, normal use
- Green: 0% to 30%, battery need to be recharged.

With equipment: Press and hold the button to power ON. The default setting is maximum (100%). Press again to select needed power level:

- Red: 100%
- Orange: 75%
- Green: 50%
- Flashing green: 25%

Press one more time to power OFF, or simply unplug the equipment. See table for autonomy of the battery with different equipment.

HEATED INSOLES LITHIUM KIT

Cut out the insoles to the desired size. Do not cut in the shaded area. ConforTeck™ insoles are not designed to be worn in direct contact with the skin. You must install the felt between your boots and your feet. You must use socks to protect your feet.

Route the "Y" shaped wire in each trouser leg. Connect the soles. Connect the other end of the "Y" shaped wire into one of the outputs of the battery.

Clean the connections for a good contact. Check that wires are in good condition. If ice forms on your connections dry them. Check occasionally. The dielectric 06-DG1CC lubricant must be applied connections to prevent oxidation.

HEATED LINER GLOVES LITHIUM KIT

The heating ConforTeck™ liners are made of stretchable polyester and are designed to be used inside your gloves or mittens. Heating elements in carbon fibre

Route the "Y" shaped wire in each sleeve of the jacket. Connect the liner. Connect the other end of the "Y" shaped wire into one of the outputs of the battery.

Clean the connections for a good contact. Check that wires are in good condition. If ice forms on your connections dry them. Check occasionally. The dielectric 06-DG1CC lubricant must be applied connections to prevent oxidation. **NEVER PUT CONFORTECK™ LINER GLOVES IN WASHING MACHINES OR TUMBLE DRYER.** Hand-wash and let it dry hanging at free air

Storage:

Store battery in a dry place at temperature between 0°C and 35°C for best results. Do not expose the rechargeable battery to temperature under -20°C or above 60°C. Expose battery to temperatures under -20°C or above 60°C for extended periods of time may cause damage to battery and possible fire. It is recommended to recharge the battery before using it after a long time without utilization and at least once a year when not used.

Li-ion batteries have a cycle of operating life. Because batteries utilize a chemical reaction, battery performance will deteriorate over time even if stored for a long period of time without being used. In addition, if the various usage conditions such as charge, discharge, ambient temperature. Are not maintained within the specified ranges, the life expectancy of the battery may be shortened. If the battery cannot maintain a charge for long periods of time, even when it is charged correctly, this may indicate it is time to change the battery. Battery that lost more than 20% of initial capacity should be replaced. Do not attempt to continue charging such battery.

General warnings related to Li-ion batteries

Do not pierce the battery (nails, screw, drill, etc.), strike (hammer or other) or otherwise subject it to strong impacts or shocks. Do not throw or drop the battery on the ground. Do not disassemble or modify the battery. Do not place the battery in microwave ovens, high-pressure containers or on cookware. Do not place the battery in or near fire, on stoves or other high temperature locations. Do not allow the battery to get wet. Do not place the battery in direct sunlight or use or store the battery inside cars in hot weather. Avoid short circuit. Never use any damaged wire or equipment. Use specific charger only. When charging, please put the battery in a fireproof container. Do not leave the battery pack and charger on wood, carpet or other flammable materials. Do not recharge battery unattended. Do not use the battery in high static energy environment where the protection device can be damaged. In the event the battery leaks and the fluid get into one's eye, do not rub the eye. Rinse well with water and immediately seek medical care.

Immediately discontinue use of the battery if, while using, charging, or storing the battery or after an impact, the battery emits an unusual smell, feels hot, changes colour or shape, or appears abnormal in any other way. You must remove the battery for observation and place in a safe open area away from any combustible material for at least 15 minutes.

Must keep Li-Ion battery pack away from children and pets.

Trouble shooting:

This device is protected against overload and short circuit. If this protection does activate, it is very important to find and repair the problem or replace the equipment or the wire that caused the protection to activate. Do not continue using faulty equipment or wire.

- **The device is dead:** The protection of the device is probably activated. To reset, simply plug the battery to the charger (as to recharge) a few seconds.
- **Device power up but shut down shortly or the equipment don't heat much:** Battery is empty or the equipment have an intermittent problem.
- **When equipment is plugged and I try to power up the device, it shows a flashing colour code green, red and orange:** Device has detected a problem with the heated equipment. *Attention: do not use this heated equipment until the problem is repaired.*

ÉQUIPEMENTS CONFORTECK INC. does not guarantee the spare parts availability or any repair services beyond the warranty period granted herein.

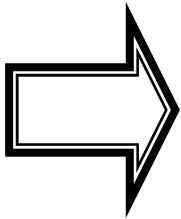
